

March 11, 2019
Town Hall Meeting

1. The meeting started at 6:00 pm. Mayor Archie Hicks was present along with the following Commissioners: Larry Adams, Kyle Matthews, Mae Luffman, Wanda Johnson and George Burns.
2. The minutes were approved as written.
3. PUBLIC COMMENT: Mark Hobson made a comment.
4. Commissioner Matthews made a motion to approve the amendment of the table of permitted uses to include parks, playgrounds, and community centers (publicly owned) in Community Shopping. Commissioner Burns seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
5. Commissioner Matthews made a motion with the condition that the Town of East Bend has purchased the land beside the Dollar General that the East Bend God and Country Celebration use it on June 29, 2019 for their festivities. Commissioner Adams seconded. The motion carried 4-1.
6. Mark Hobson asked if anyone would be opposed to him putting something up temporary to stop people from driving on the property beside Dollar General. Since the sale of the property to the Town has not gone through yet the board could not tell him that he could do that. They didn't oppose it, but he would have to do it on his own.
7. Commissioner Matthews made a motion to approve the Water Conservation Revision. Commissioner Burns seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
8. Mayor Hicks reported that the Town should close on the purchase of the land beside Dollar General on Friday, March 15, 2019.
9. Budget Workshop will be on Monday, March 18, 2019.
10. Gavin Brannon reported that the water is back in the tank that was cleaned out and that everything looks good so far.
11. A Community Park Meeting will be held on Tuesday March 12 at 6:00 pm at the East Bend Public Library.
12. Chief Shore is going to get some prices on software equipment and other sources to help with the web site. He also gave a police report.
13. Commissioner Burns made a motion to approve all bills and any that comes in until the next meeting. Commissioner Matthews seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
14. Commissioner Burns made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Matthews seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
