

May 13, 2019
Town Hall Meeting

1. The meeting started at 6:00 pm. Mayor Archie Hicks was present along with the following Commissioners: Larry Adams, Kyle Matthews, Mae Luffman, Wanda Johnson and George Burns.
2. Commissioner Adams said that in the minutes it states that Neil Nichols asked that Pauline Street from First National Bank driveway to Alex's driveway be closed for the God and Country Celebration. However, they no longer need this closure. The minutes were approved as written.
3. The Executive Session minutes were approved as written.
4. PUBLIC COMMENT: Mark Hobson addressed the Board about the importance of displaying the American Flag on the town park property. Other attendees also spoke in favor of displaying the flag. A question was raised about the final decisions for the park. Mayor Hicks said the Board would make the final decision.
5. Mayor Hicks said that he had went back over the January and February minutes and tried to flesh out everything because more details were needed for the grant. Commissioner Adams had some questions about the membership of the Steering Committee since he did not remember meeting with that group or the actions that were taken at the meeting. Commissioner Luffman told him he could be on the committee that will meet tomorrow night. Commissioner Matthews made a motion to approve the January 14, 2019 amended minutes with the removal of Commissioner Larry Adams from the January minute revision. Commissioner Burns seconded. The motion carried 4-1.
6. Commissioner Matthews made a motion to approve the amended February 11, 2019 minutes. Commissioner Luffman seconded. The motion carried 4-1.
7. Town Square Calendar/Guidelines – Mayor Hicks said it would be a long time before the park would be up and running, but activities are being held there now. The Board needs to be thinking about some guidelines. Commissioner Adams asked about the name of Town Square and that no name has been decided on. Commissioner Matthews recommended a suggestion box.
8. Ronnie Fletcher of Fletcher Cars won the sealed bid to purchase the Crown Vic.
9. Mayor Hicks wanted to thank Mr. Ben Peacock for all the hard work he did to help update the web site. We now have a goggle map, updated calendar. Mr. Peacock would like to have some new photos to add to the web site. Commissioner Matthews is going to try to get him the pdf for the newsletter. The town really appreciates what Mr. Peacock has done for us.
10. Commissioner Matthews made a motion to have a public hearing on June 10, 2019 at 5:45 pm for the budget. Commissioner Johnson seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
11. Chief Shore gave a police report.
12. Commissioner Matthews made a motion to approve all bills and any that comes in until the next meeting. Commissioner Johnson seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
13. Commissioner Matthews made a motion to suspend the rules to vote on going into executive session. Commissioner Luffman seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
14. Commissioner Matthews made a motion to go into executive session for personnel reasons. Commissioner Burnes seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
15. After coming out of executive session Commissioner Luffman made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Matthews seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
